Established in 2007, CURE Foundation seeks to promote global healthcare and education. CURE Founder and Best Medical International President Krishnan Suthanthiran believes that education is the most effective way to eliminate poverty and promote global health, understanding, and peace. After all, everyone deserves the best healthcare. By working with citizens, medical professionals, governmental and non-governmental organizations, educational and charitable institutions around the world, CURE seeks to eradicate contagious disease, malnutrition and poverty by providing superior healthcare and education at a lower cost.

Our **Total Health™ Program** is a pioneering effort to focus on **prevention, early detection, and effective treatment to achieve total cure**. CURE-sponsored medical centers and clinics will be committed to **Proactive Healthcare™**, a new ideology in which there is **full transparency of benefits, clinical outcome, and cost**.

Funding Sources:

- (1) The medical centers, express/mobile clinics and educational institutions will raise money through **charitable contributions**.
- (2) The **naming rights** of medical centers, express/mobile clinics, and departments **will be sold**.
- (3) Money will be raised through **low interest loans, collateralizing the medical centers and express/mobile clinics and their assets** for 10- to 30-year loans at interest rates ranging from 4–6 percent.
- (4) Land, buildings, equipment and supplies will be obtained as **donations or grants from governmental and non-governmental agencies and private and public foundations** as much as possible.

CURE Foundation will focus on establishing:

- **Preventive Care Specialists (PCS)**. These individuals will have the qualifications comparable to a nurse; and their occupations could be that of a dietician, social worker, physical therapist, physical trainer, or dental assistant. In training preventive care specialists we will focus on prevention of alcohol and drug abuse, obesity, diabetes and other disorders.
- **Geriatric Care Specialists (GCS)**. These individuals will help maintain the health of elderly individuals by preventing accidents, improper and over-use of medications, and other problems. The aim here is to reduce the number of unwarranted deaths due to medical mismanagement of elderly individuals.
- **CURE U.S. Health Corps** – will enroll as many as one million healthcare volunteers in the U.S.
- **CURE International Health Corps** – will enroll as many as five million healthcare volunteers globally.
- **CURE Global Insurance** – a private, non-profit, non-governmental insurance company will spend no more than 10 percent for administrative costs, maintain 5 percent as a reserve fund, and use at least 80 percent of the premium to provide Total Health™ program benefits to the insured. Annual increases will be limited to those similar to cost of living. Proactive Healthcare™ will call for the costs for procedures to be standardized and publicized, which will allow the consumer to pay a fair price.
- **CURE Global Purchasing Organization** – will help hospitals around the world purchase the best quality products at reasonable prices and find the means to make them affordable and accessible.
- **CURE Global Standard of Care**. CURE initiatives are designed to establish a global standard of care.
- **CURE Institutes in the fields of neurological sciences; breast, prostate, lung, and gynecologic cancers; and other diseases**.
