## Message From The President

The year 2009 is now history. The past two years have been challenging for many of us with the global economic crisis, high unemployment, loss of jobs, and decreased value of our investments and retirement accounts.

We begin 2010 with more optimism and hope for a better year and things to come. We publicly launched CURE Foundation's Global Perspective for proactive health care (full transparency of cost, benefit and clinical outcome). Also, we introduced the Total Health™ program (prevention, early detection, effective treatment and total cure). We mailed CURE Foundation's goals to all members of the U.S. Congress, Senate, Governors and the President. Two of the recommendations made by CURE Foundation have been included in the current version of the Senate Health Care Bill. One of them is the establishment of non-profit, non-governmental private insurance companies as an alternative to the public insurance option. The other is mandating them to spend 80-85 percent of the insurance premium for the benefit of the insured. This is significantly better than the current practice of private health insurance carriers spending approximately 60 percent or less for the benefit of the insured.

We plan to establish express and mobile clinics and medical centers, as well as launching CURE Global Insurance, CURE Global Purchasing Organization, CURE International Health Corps, and CURE U.S. Health Corps. Please join us, and together we can make a better health care system and reduce the cost by as much as 30 percent.
